Finally, the Aphasia Institute offers you an opportunity to watch our community programs in action at the Pat Arato Aphasia Centre, then teaches you how to develop SCA™— based programs at your own organization.

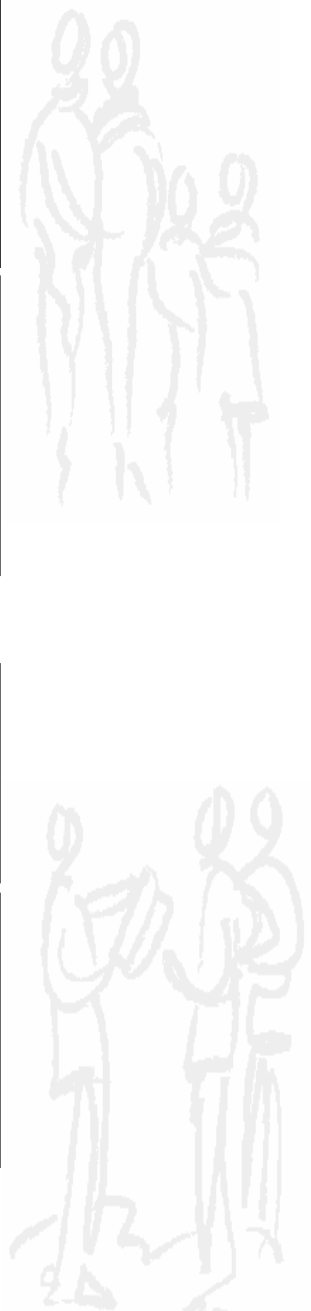
